Grant Expectations

Quarterly Reporting

- PPR
- PFR
- Trial Balance
- Quarterly Narrative Report (QNR) detailed and relevant to the correct quarter

Monthly Reporting Costs

- Much like the formula WIOA funds, please post and draw monthly (before the 20th)
- This is especially important as we get through the last half of this grant
- These dollars are "use or lose" (this isn't necessarily bad if you cannot spend, you just need to let us know)
- We do not expect any extensions beyond June 30



Grant Expectations – Ultimate Goal

- Create new QUALITY Registered Apprenticeship programs
 - Best solution is not synonymous with fastest and cheapest; does not translate into a positive ROI
- Meaningfully expand existing Registered Apprenticeship programs
- Besides offering apprenticeship as part of the BST menu of services, Tasks include:
 - Business outreach and engagement
 - Identify and work to revise existing work process schedules that fit employers' needs
 - Advising businesses on competitive wage data (O*Net, Glassdoor, etc) for their selected program occupation(s) and assisting in the development of the progressive wage schedule
 - Identify and provide information to aid in the selection of training providers for programs in development
 - Complete the Standards Builder registration process on behalf of the employer
- *Skills include*: Problem Solving; Critical and Creative Thinking; Moving Beyond Hurdles; Communicating ROI

Using Data For Grant Expectations

- Logging outreach events and employers
 - Outreach Events were these planned events with agendas? Employers were present?
 - Employers Engaged Should only enter if employer showed interest. Unless you've had a meeting specific about exploring apprenticeship, should not list them (more than just mentioning in a general business outreach)
 - Getting at that "true outreach events" and "meaningful engagement"
- Current data does not show the whole picture
- Need data to provide better understanding of the process
- Trends for size of business, industry, occupation
- Over time provide insight into realistic expectations
