


Learning Styles Survey

This short survey can help you identify the ways you learn best. Knowing more about your learning style will make you a more effective learner. You will also get some helpful study tips specifically for your learning style.










- 1. Access Learning Styles Survey through the **Self-Survey** tab.
- 2. Select Learning Styles Survey.
- 3. Select Start to begin.
- 4. Select **Restore** to see results from a previously taken self-survey.
- 5. For each item, select the facial expression of the frequency that best describes you.
- 6. **Start Over** or **Save** your self-survey.
- 7. Use the **back button** to return to a previous question.

Learning Styles:

- Auditory: You learn best through your ears. You remember things through the sounds related to the experience.
- Visual: You learn best through your eyes. Learning is easier for you when information is presented visually.
- Tactile: You learn best through physical experience. You are a hands-on person.

- 8. Your results display your primary, secondary, and tertiary learning style. Read the descriptions about each learning style. The learning style with the highest score may be your preferred learning style. You should only use the Learning Styles Survey as a general guide to your learning style.
