




Reality Check

How much money will you need to support your lifestyle? What careers match your financial needs? Take a Reality Check to find out!












- 1. Access Reality Check through the **Self-Survey** tab.
- 2. Select Reality Check.
- 3. There are two ways to start Reality Check. Select Start to begin with calculating your lifestyle expenses and seeing how those fit in with careers, select Start with a Career to pick your desired career and see if your lifestyle matches.
- 4. Select **Restore** to see results from a previously taken self-survey.
- 5. Select the expenses that fit your desired lifestyle. Select the **arrow** to view the next question. Some categories will allow you to select more than one expense.
- Use the forward and back arrows or icons to advance/return to a question.
- 7. **Start Over** or **Save** your self-survey.
- If you did not begin Reality Check by selecting a career, your final question will ask you to select Career Clusters you are interested in or select not sure. Select results to see your results.

- 9. Your Total Expenses will display when the assessment is completed. If you began with a Career, your results will tell you if your lifestyle matches your career choice. Use the drop-down menu if you want to change your location.
- 10. Review your expenses in the table at the bottom of the screen. Select an expense to update your response.
- 11. If you did not select a career to start, select **Your Custom Careers List** to view a list of careers that match your required annual salary, location, and cluster choices. If you did select a career to start, you can **Choose a Different Career.**
- 12. Select a **Title** for more information about that career. Compare careers by checking the box next to two careers and selecting **Compare**. Select **thumbs up** to add to favorites.
- 13. Change your location or career cluster if desired.
- 14. **Start Over, Save** your self-survey results with a note to your dashboard, or **Export PDF** for a report of your results.
