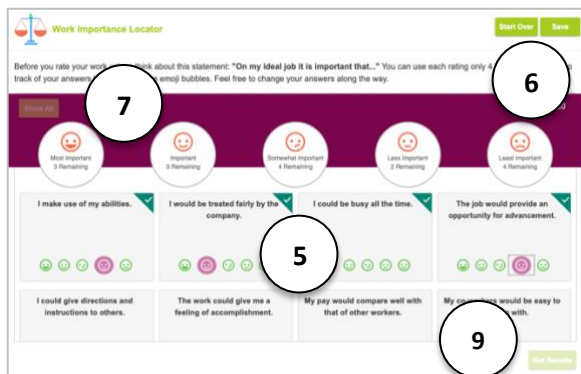
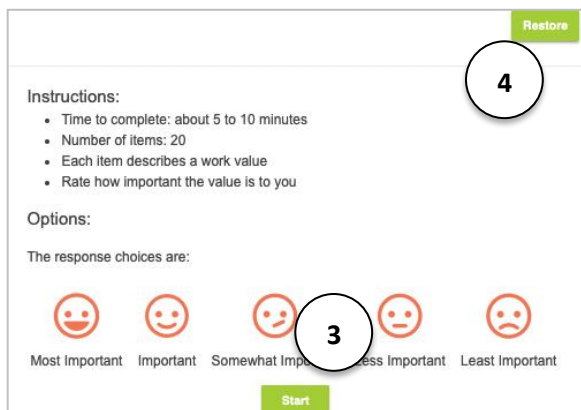
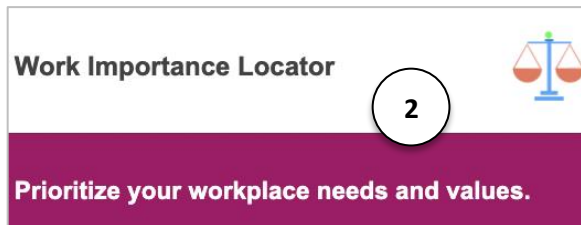




Work Importance Locator

Work Importance Locator helps you find careers that match your work values. Work values are things like achievement, work environment, and work relationships. Working in a place that matches your values will make your career more satisfying.



1. Access Work Importance Locator through the **Self-Survey** tab.
2. Select **Work Importance Locator**.
3. Select **Start** to begin the self-survey.
4. Select **Restore** to see results from a previously taken self-survey.
5. Use the **small facial expression** to rate how important each value is. Each expression can only be used four times, so answers may need to be changed along the way.
6. **Start Over** or **Save** your self-survey.
7. Use the **large facial expression button** to filter and keep track of responses. Select **Show All** to return to the rating page.
8. A rating can be used four times. After four uses, it cannot be selected unless you change a previous answer.
9. Complete the ratings and select **Get Results**.
