# Why Submit an Online WARN notification?

The Illinois Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN) requires applicable employers to provide advanced notification of a plant closure or mass layoff. This applies to employers with 75 or more full-time workers.

- Definition of "Mass Layoff" triggering notice requirements:
  - 25 or more full-time employees are laid off, and they constitute one-third or more of the full-time employees at the site, OR
  - 250 or more full-time employees are laid off at a single site.
- Definition of "Plant Closure" triggering notice requirements:
  - Closure of a site that employs 50 or more employees, impacting all workers.

Illinois Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (WARN) Act.

# What the Notice must Contain:

- The name and address of the employment site(s) where the plant closing or mass layoff will occur.
- Whether the planned action is expected to be permanent or temporary and if the entire plant is to be closed—a statement to that effect.
- The expected date of the first separation, and the anticipated schedule for making separations.
- The job titles of positions to be affected, and the number of affected employees in each job classification (for multiple sites, provide a list per site).
- A statement as to the existence of any applicable bumping rights.
- The name of each union representing the affected employees, and the name and address of the chief elected officer of each union—if none exist, so state; and
- The name and telephone number of a company official to contact for further information.

Also, please include the employer's Federal Identification Number, or FEIN, for the dislocating company on all WARN correspondence.

## Illinois WARN Requirements

- Option 1: Submit using an Illinois WorkNet Account Login
  - Create or use an existing Illinois WorkNet account and login to submit a WARN through the Illinois WorkNet WARN Portal. An account is recommended if you plan to submit multiple WARN notices or need to file a supplemental notice for an existing layoff.
- Option 2: Submit as a Guest

  - No account is required, but without signing in, you cannot view past submissions.

# LAYOFF ASSISTANCE FOR EMPLOYERS

## WARN Reporting and Services

The *Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity* (DCEO) and *Local Workforce Innovation Areas* (LWIAs) provide services to employers in Illinois who are planning or have gone through a layoff. Layoffs can be reported by individuals, employers, DCEO, and LWIAs.

The Illinois Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (WARN) Act requires applicable employers to provide advanced notification of a plant closure or mass layoff. Refer to the Resources section for information about Illinois WARN Requirements and Procedures.

The State Dislocated Worker Unit will contact an employer upon submission of the WARN correspondence to coordinate Rapid Response workshops to inform workers and employers about employment and retraining services designed to help impacted workers retain employment when feasible or obtain re-employment as soon as possible. Employers can include an alternative contact in the WARN correspondence to coordinate Rapid Response services if applicable.

## **Rapid Response Services**

No employer wants to experience laying off employees; however, as layoffs occur, inviting the State's Dislocated Worker Unit to meet with affected workers before the layoff allows employees to access services and programs to help them through this difficult time.

Rapid Response Services are available at no cost to employers undergoing employee layoffs. The Rapid Response team coordinates with the employer to inform workers about benefits and services

WARN correspondence should be submitted online, by email or by mail. If you cannot submit online or by email, the notice should be mailed to the Illinois Office of Employment & Training.

Furthermore, in "any investigation or proceeding under this Act," the Director has the authority to "examine the books and records of an employer" in order to determine whether a violation of this Act has occurred."
