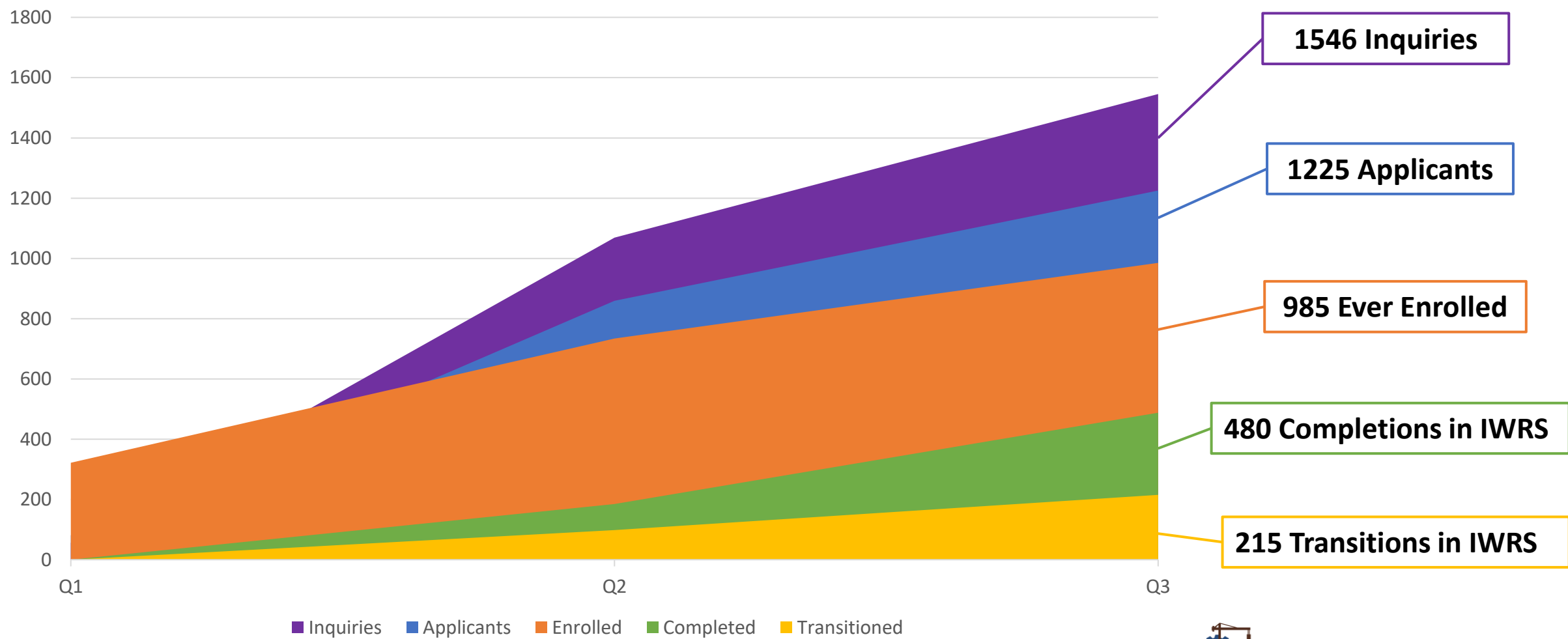

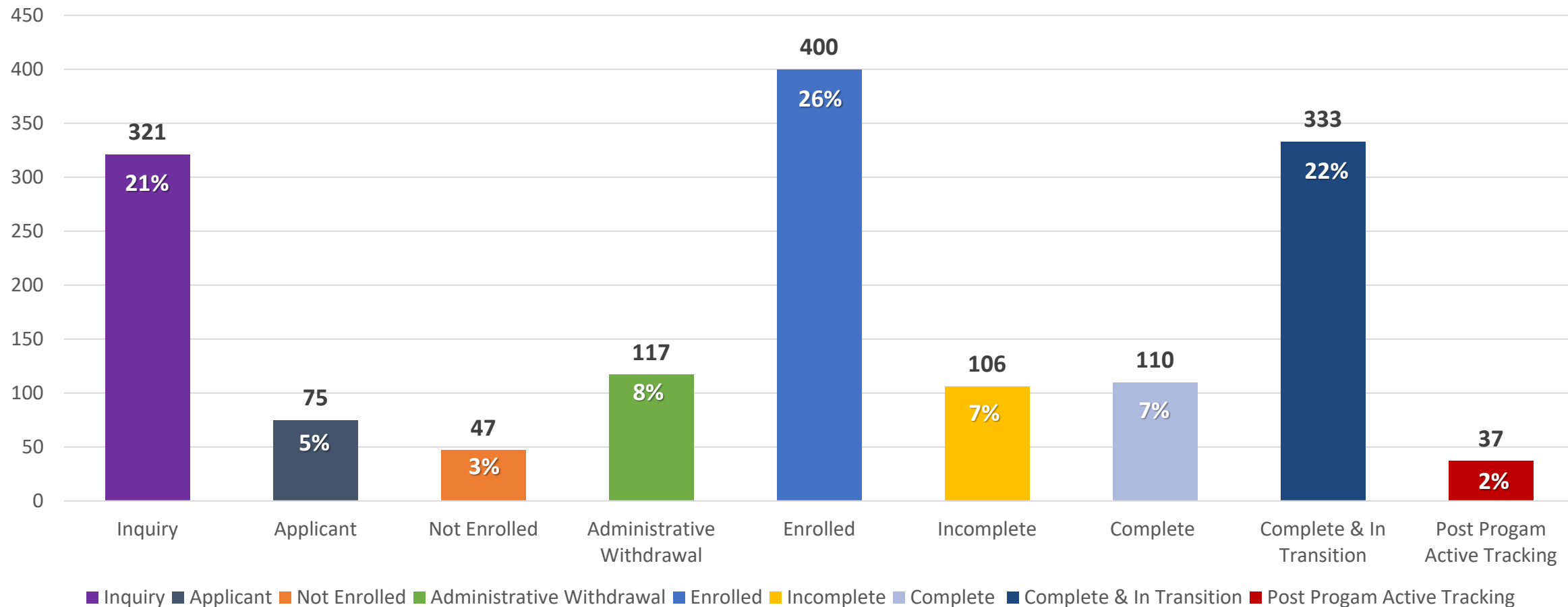
Pre-Apprenticeship Program Participant Data

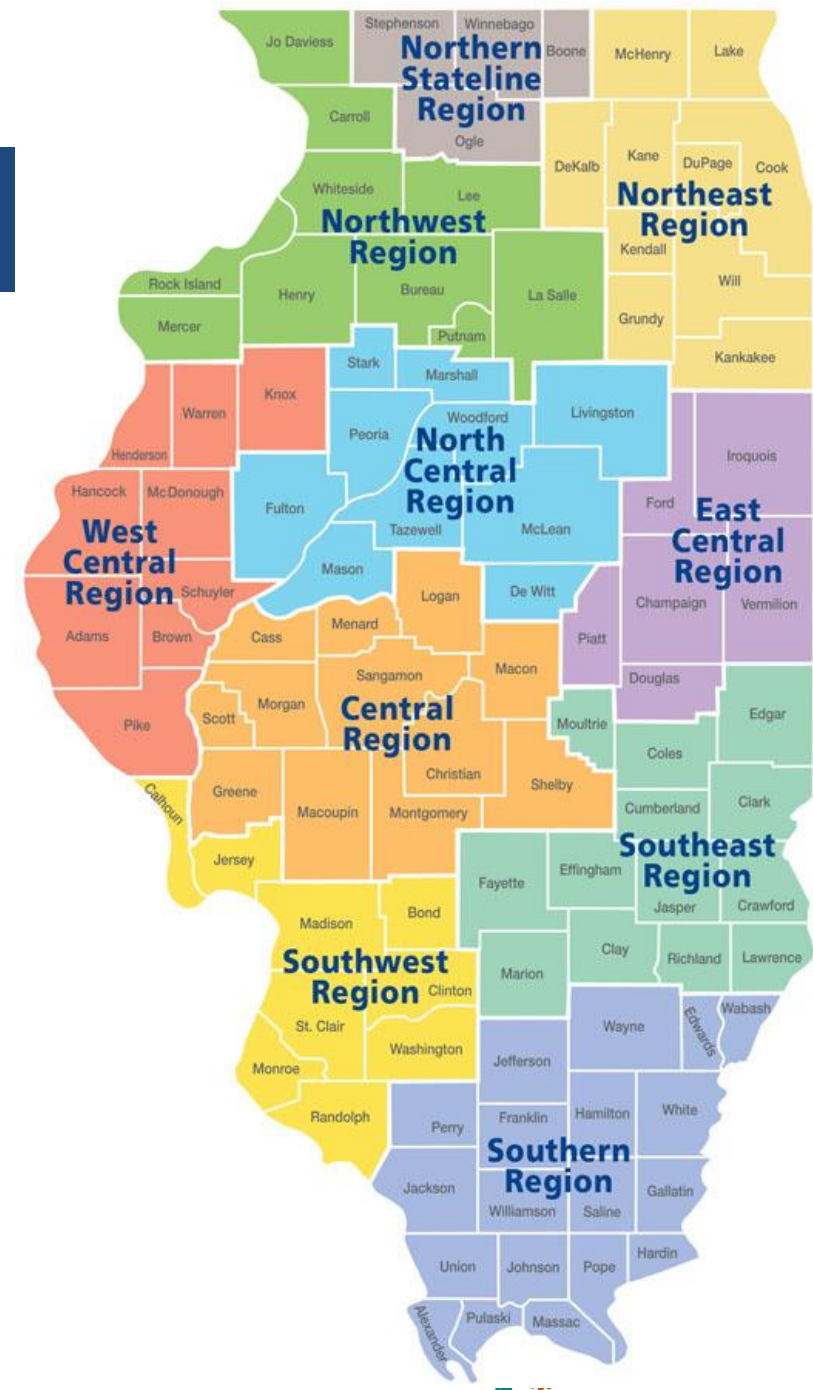
