24. There is documentation reflecting that meaningful 2-way communication is occurring with the participant within a 90-day timeframe.


25. If the participant has a gap in service, it was less than 180 calendar days from the date of the most recent service, and it was for one of the allowable reasons.

26. All services and status records have been appropriately recorded (ended) in IWDS.

27. WIOA Title I services, other than self-service or information-only activities, are not provided to individuals who are not registered in IWDS and are not participants.
