MONITORING SYSTEM USER ACCEPTANCE TESTING

PURPOSE



INITIATION & DISCOVERY

Define the scope of the project and timeline. Build and approve the project plan and schedule. Research and define the technical requirements and the business requirements. Receive approval on the user stories that will go into the development sprints.



DEVELOPMENT SPRINTS

Start development work to set up the system's infrastructure of the system and begin development on approved user stories. Short development cycles allow teams to develop, deploy, and iterate on their product with frequent feedback from stakeholders.



USER ACCEPTANCE TESTING (UAT)

In User Acceptance Testing, business stakeholders determine whether an application or feature fulfills its purpose. Because development is happening in cycles, testing happens more frequently to ensure that work is being completed towards the product's vision.



TRAINING

Hands-on sessions will be conducted to train the monitoring staff on the new Monitoring system prior to go-live. End users will be provided instruction resources in a variety of formats including documents, videos, and quick start guides.



DATA MIGRATION & GO LIVE

Data entry will be paused on ACME and historical data moved to the new Monitoring application. Once migrated, users will only need to use the new Monitoring application.

Event Search

Purpose: The event search page includes a listing of all events. This includes the last five years of events that were migrated over and any new events that are created. The left panel includes various filters that can be used to filter down the list of events to narrow your search.

Additional Features:

- **Hamburger** - In the right corner, there is a hamburger icon that allows you to add additional data columns.
- **Paging** – At the bottom of the event listing, there are paging features to select the number of results that display per page and move from page to page.

Monitoring Event Page

Purpose: The Monitoring Event Page is the landing page for an individual event. It displays detailed information about an event and contains the event's instrument, findings, and letters. There is also a place to choose participants to attach to the event and upload files related to the event.

Additional Features: Use the left side navigation panel to easily jump from section to section. You can also go back to the full listing of events by selecting the Back to Events List button.

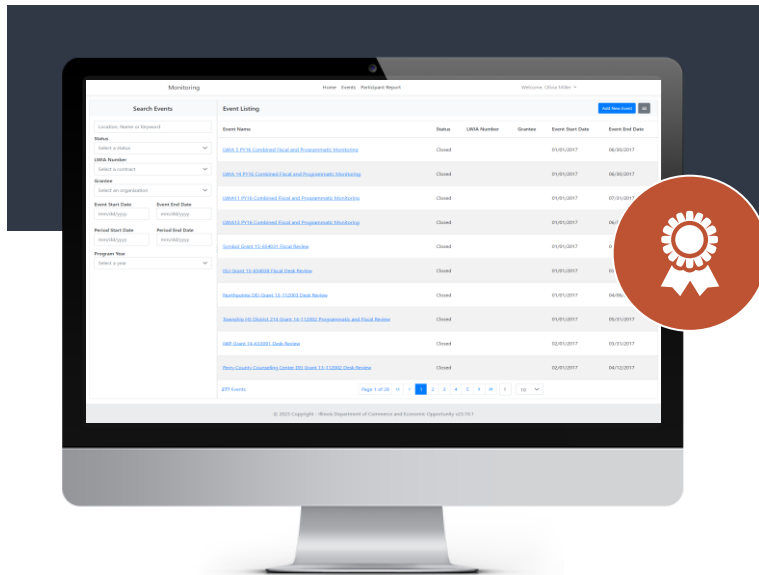
Create a New Event

Purpose: The Create a New Event wizard is a process driven to create the yearly monitoring events. The monitoring admin can search an organization, enter event details, choose the event components to include, and identify members of the Monitoring team to complete event.

Real Data: LWIA Listing, LWIA Address, Funding Stream Information, Components, Identify Monitoring Team, Save

In Progress: Event Name will be moved to earlier in the process in a future release to assist with saving event details

Monitoring Event Page: Each event has a monitoring event page that highlights the event information, selected participants, instrument, files, findings, and letters associated with the event.



Create an Event: New events can be created by identifying the organization, event information, components associated with the event, and monitors associated with the event.
